

2026 Schedule of Fees and Charges

UQ Skills is a Registered Training Organisation and operates in accordance with applicable legislation and the Standards for Registered Training Organisations. UQ Skills is entitled to charge fees for services provided to students undertaking a program of study. These fees are for items such as program materials, administrative support, student services and training and assessment services. We review our fees schedule regularly and endeavour to keep the cost of training down.

When and how do I pay?

Fees are payable when an Application/Registration Form has been approved. Fees must be paid in full within 7 days of receiving an Invoice for payment from UQ Skills. We may cancel an enrolment or discontinue training if fees are not paid as required. Payment methods include bank transfer, B-pay and card payment. Payment details and authorisation form is attached to the Application/Registration form.

Student Cancellation

Students who cancel their enrolment after a training program has commenced will not be entitled to a refund of fees and will incur the entire cost regardless of whether they are on a payment plan or not.

Can I get a refund?

Yes - If you give notice to cancel your enrolment more than 10 days prior to the commencement of a program you will be entitled to a full (100%) refund of fees paid.

If you give notice to cancel your enrolment less than 10 days prior to the commencement of a program you will be entitled to a 75% refund of fees paid. The amount retained (25%) by UQ Skills is required to cover the costs of staff and resources which will have already been committed based on your initial intention to undertake the training.

If you give notice to cancel your enrolment after a training program has commenced, you will not be entitled to a refund of fees. Discretion may be exercised by the Student Services Manager if there is extenuating or significant personal circumstance that led to your withdrawal.

If for any reason UQ Skills is unable to fulfil its service agreement with a student, UQ Skills must refund the student's proportion of fees paid for services not delivered.

How do I get a refund?

To obtain a refund you are required to give written notice to cancel your enrolment and complete a Refund Request Form. Written notice may be in the form of an email or letter. Where refunds are approved, payment will be paid via electronic funds transfer using the authorised bank account or the credit/debit card used for initial payment

This payment will be made within 30 days from the time you gave written notice to cancel your enrolment.

Are my fees protected in case I need a refund?

Yes - UQ Skills has a responsibility to protect the fees paid by students.

Do I pay GST in my tuition fees?

No – Training tuition fees are GST exempt under section 38-85 GSTR 2003/1 Goods and Services Tax, tax ruling. The ruling explains the supply of a course for ‘professional or trade course’ is a GST-free education course. GST does apply on the payment of some miscellaneous charges.

Changes to terms and conditions

UQ Skills reserves the right to amend the conditions of the student’s enrolment at any time.

If amendments are made that effect the student’s enrolment the student will be informed 7 days prior to changes taking effect.

Payment Plans

You will be able to request a Payment Plan upon enrolment. These plans have been designed to limit the amount paid by students upfront and is structured to collect fees as the course progresses.
